## Supporting Our Troops

Alares is currently working in support of US Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), Architect Engineer (A/E) services for infrastructure improvement projects at the Forward Operations Base (FOB) Tiger, located at Fort Dix Military Installation, New Jersey. The FOB is modeled after a typical base in Iraq, and is designed to immerse and train Soldiers in the living and working conditions of a Forward Operating Base in a theater of war prior to overseas deployment.



Alares is working in a subcontract capacity to the USACE prime contractor for the design and permitting of a six-acre grey water and sanitary leach field, and 5,200 square-foot shower/latrine facility that will support up to 2,500 troops per day.

Supporting activities performed by Alares have included the design and implementation of field investigations used in the preliminary Basis of Design (BOD) of proposed site features, field supervision for the collection of geotechnical soil samples by drilling and test pitting, oversight of Unexploded Ordnance (UXO) surveys completed prior to intrusive activities at the FOB, and support of field investigations for wetlands delineation and Threaten & Endangered species evaluation.
